Price is a one-time fee for perpetual use of all six GoVenture products. There are no yearly subscription or maintenance fees. Shipping costs to US/Canada are included. Purchases are tax free in the US. Purchases in Canada are subject to GST/HST.

A Seat License allows for any number of people to use the software at one correctional facility. The number of Seats purchased determines the maximum number of people that may use any combination of the six GoVenture software programs at the same time (concurrently). For example, with a 5-Seat license, five student-inmates may concurrently use GoVenture Small Business, or three may use GoVenture Entrepreneur while two use GoVenture Financial Literacy. In both instances, no more than 5 people are using GoVenture at exactly the same time.

Individual GoVenture products may also be purchased. Various licensing and pricing options are available, starting as low as \$249 (government and nonprofit pricing).
